Coloured Caterpillar

Description

Piece together the parts of a paper caterpillar.

Competencies

- Development of fine motor skills
- Planning skills

Materials

- Paper in various colours
- Glue
- Scissors (adult use only)
- Crayons

Preparation

- Print out the various template shapes on the appropriate coloured paper, as indicated on the template
- Alternatively, print the templates on white paper so participants can colour them with crayons
- Cut out the shapes before the program or allow caregivers to cut out the shapes for participants
- Prepare the room for a program that uses glue

Implementation

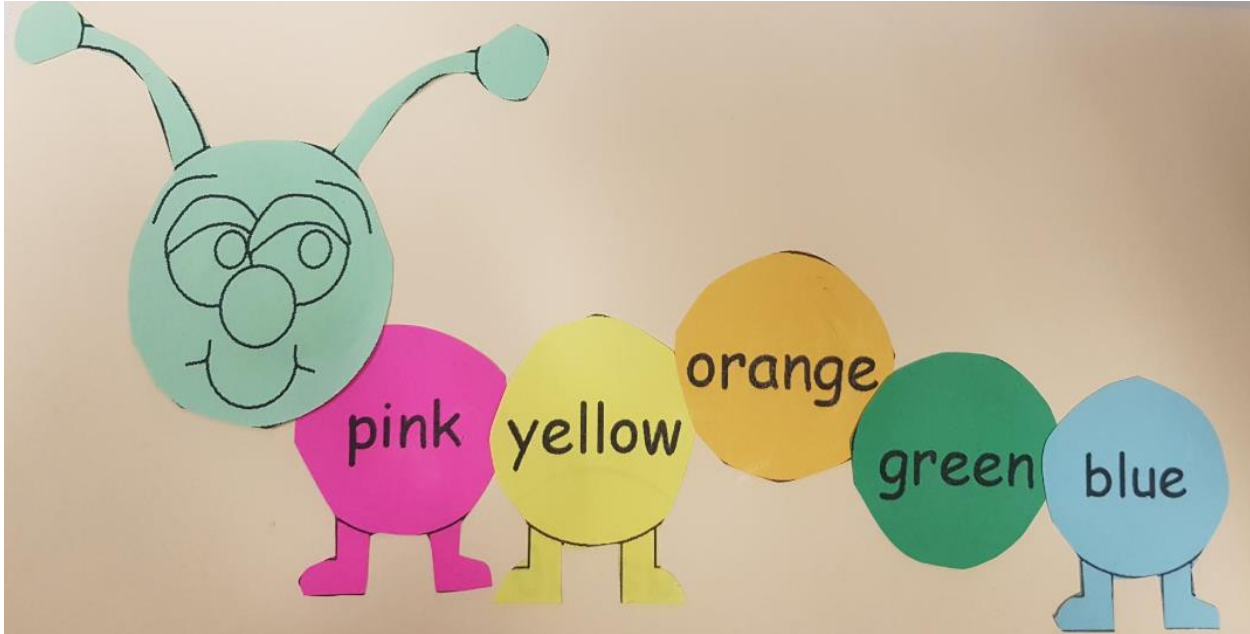
1. Provide each participant with a caterpillar head, several pieces of the body (4-6 is recommended), a sheet of paper to glue the pieces onto, and glue
2. Combine this craft with the book suggestions below or any book about caterpillars for a story time program

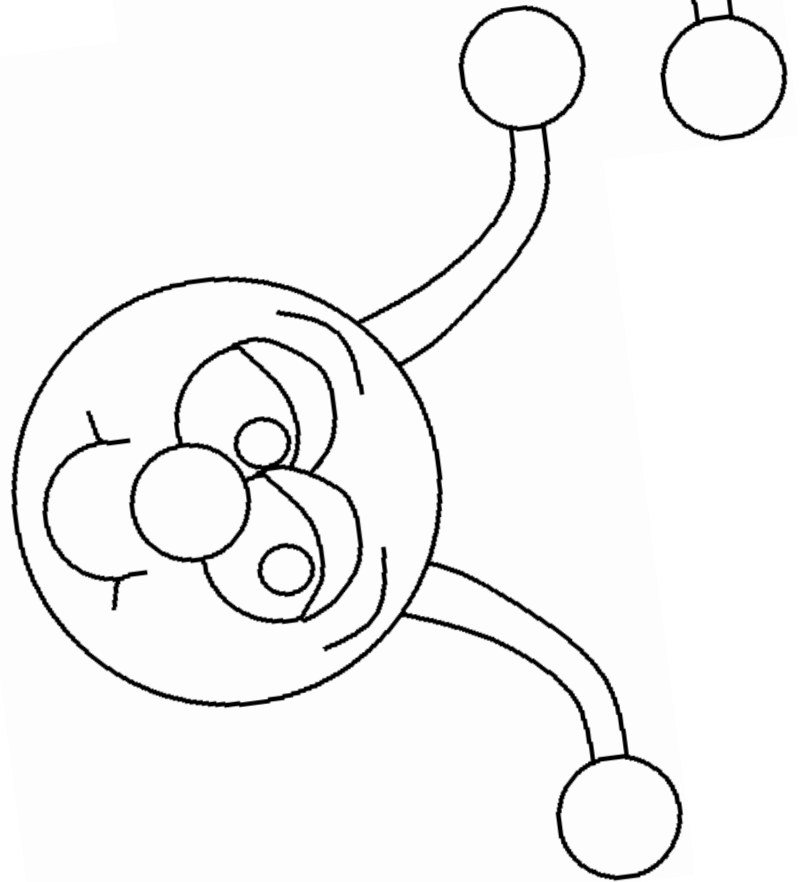
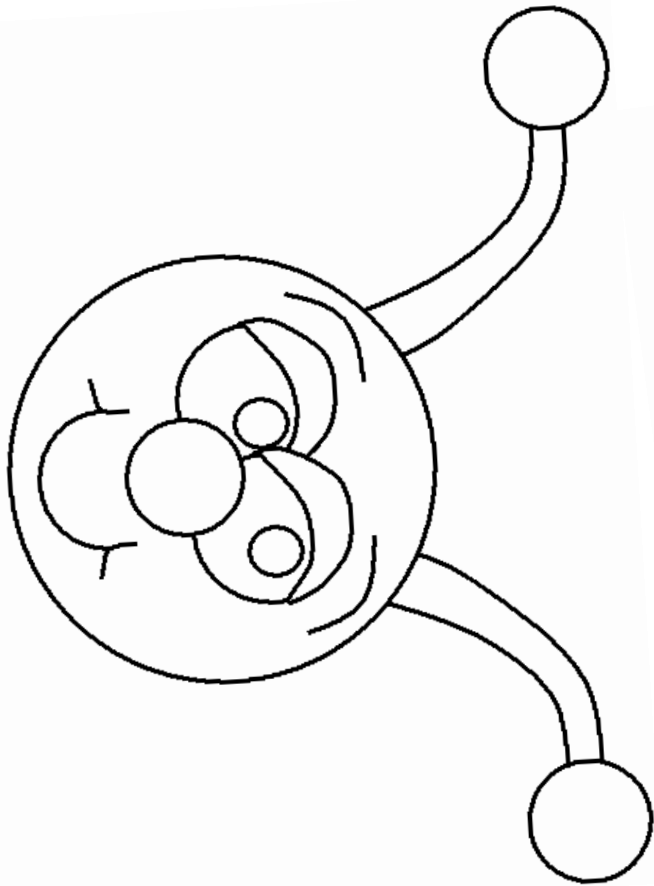
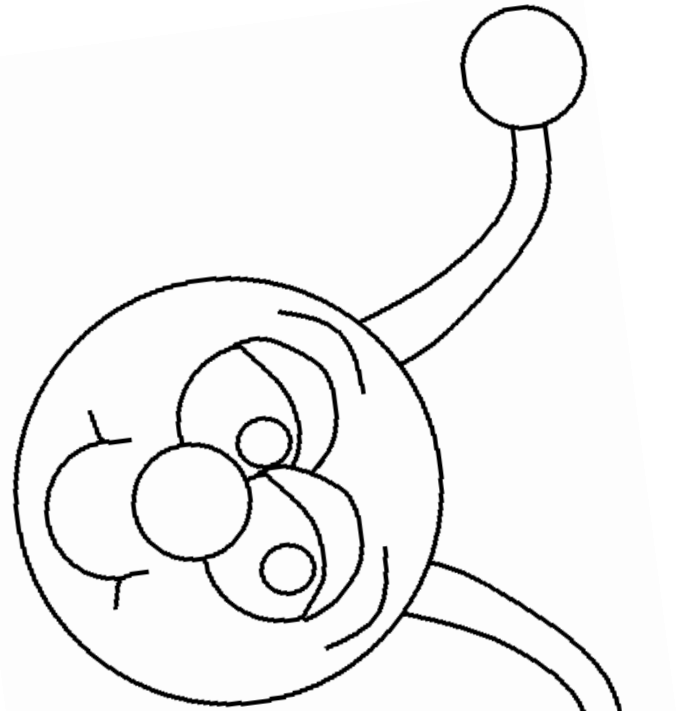
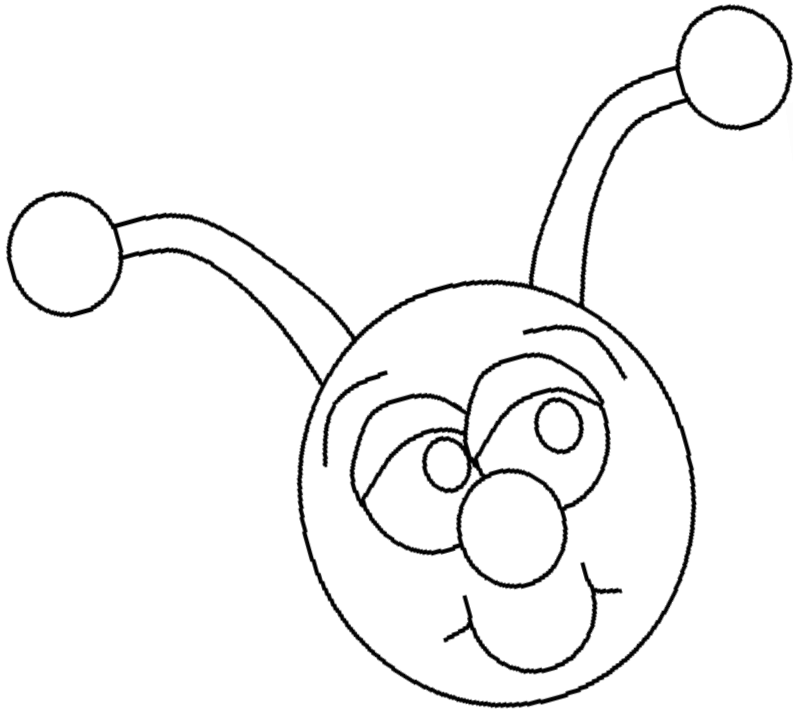
